Renew Your License

Your cannabis cultivation license is valid for one year. You can renew your license up to 60 days before your license expires. For example, if your license was granted on November 1st, you can begin the renewal process the following September 1st.

The Renewal Process:

When your license expiration is within the 60-day window for renewal, the licensee will see in the **Action** column a link to **Renew License**.

Note: Be sure you renew before your expiration date, shown clearly in the **Expires On** column. On the day the license expires, if you haven't yet renewed, the licensee will receive an email stating that you can still renew after paying a **late fee**.

After clicking the link to begin, the first screen shows some basic information about your license. You cannot make changes to the fields listed here, but if changes are needed, you can submit a [DCC Notification and Request Form 27](#) and/or a Science Amendment through your public user account.  - D. A person acting as an agent, such as an accountant or attorney, for the commercial cannabis business for a share of the profits.
 - E. A broker who is engaging in activities for the commercial cannabis business for a share of the profits.
 - F. A salesperson who earns a commission.

Financial interest holders do not include any of the following:

1. A bank or financial institution whose interest constitutes a loan;
2. Persons whose only financial interest in the commercial cannabis business is through an interest in a diversified mutual fund, blind trust, or similar instrument;
3. Persons whose only financial interest is a security interest, lien, or encumbrance on property that will be used by the commercial cannabis business; and
4. Persons who hold a share of stock that is less than 10 percent of the total shares in a publicly traded or privately held company.

Acknowledge Declarations

DECLARATION

Declarations are formal written statements in which the designated responsible party declares under oath that the contents are true. In this section, the designated responsible party will need to read the declarations and check the box if they agree that the business entity will comply and abide with the terms and conditions as defined in the statements.

- * 1. The license type being requested is only valid for the premises location:
- * 2. The cultivation premises location is located beyond at least a 600-foot radius from a prohibited location (including but not limited to schools, day care centers, and youth centers) or another radius specified by, as required by section 26054 of the Business and Professions Code:

If the licensed entity has 20 or more employees on payroll at any time during the licensed period, the applicant entity is required to enter into, or demonstrate that the applicant entity has already entered into, and will abide by the terms of a labor peace agreement by providing a copy of the signature page of the agreement:
- * 6. If the licensed entity has not yet received a seller's permit, the business is currently applying for a seller's permit:
- * 7. If the cultivation license type is indoor, the local fire department has been notified of the cultivation site:
- * 8. I agree pest management activities associated with this license shall comply with CA state laws and regulations applicable to commercial cannabis cultivation, including but not limited to Medicinal and Adult-Use Cannabis Regulation and Safety Act and Title 3, Div. 8, Ch. 1 Sections 8106 and 8307 of the CA Code of Regulations and state and federal pesticide use laws pursuant to Div. 6 and 7 of the Food and Agricultural Code. I am responsible for compliance with subsequent updates to laws and regulations. I acknowledge and understand that issuance of a license by CDFA does not constitute approval for use of any pesticide on cannabis. I shall contact the County Agricultural Commissioner regarding legal use of pesticides on cannabis prior to using any active ingredient or product and review the CA Department of Pesticide Regulation's guidance documents for cannabis cultivators:
- * 9. If the licensed entity has more than one employee, the licensed entity shall attest that the licensee employs, or will employ within one year of receiving a license, one supervisor and one employee who have successfully completed a Cal-OSHA 30-hour general industry outreach course offered by a training provider that is authorized by an OSHA Training Institute Education Center to provide the course:
